

SNOWFLAKE (3D) MAKING COMPETITION

Dear Parents,

The School is going to organise **INTRA-CLASS SNOWFLAKE (3D) MAKING COMPETITION** on the occasion of Christmas.

WHAT IS A SNOWFLAKE?

A small piece of snow that falls from the sky. A snowflake begins to form when an extremely cold water droplet freezes into a pollen or dust particle in the sky. This creates an ice crystal. As the ice crystal falls to the ground, water vapour freezes onto the primary crystal, building new crystals – the six arms of the snowflake.
